Dr. Granell is professor of Economic International Organization at University of Barcelona and Honoree General Director of the European Commission. His academic background includes a Ph. D. in Political, Economic and Trade Sciences at University of Barcelona. He also studied at Institute of European Studies (Geneva), the International Marketing Institute (Cambridge), and the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy. He has been visiting professor at Georgetown University. Among his professional activities during sixteen years in the European Commission, he was head of the Commission negotiating team for the accession of Finland as well as head of the area of relations with the Pacific, Caribbean and Indian Ocean countries. He has published an extensive number of books and articles on external trade, economic international relations and European integration.
