lan Bond, CVO, has been the Political Counsellor for the Foreign Security and Policy Group at the British Embassy in Washington, DC, since September 2007. In that role, he is responsible for maintaining and developing UK/US relations on foreign and security policy relating to Latin America and the Caribbean, Europe (including NATO policy), Russia and Central Asia, Afghanistan and Pakistan. He has worked predominately on security and European issues during his career. His other postings have included time as Deputy Head of the Mission of the UK delegation to the Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe (2000-2004), Deputy Head of the Eastern Department in the Foreign Office dealing with Russia and the former Soviet Union (1997-2000), as First Secretary in the British Embassy in Moscow dealing with political and military affairs from 1993 to 1996 and working at NATO on conventional arms control issues between 1987 and 1990. Prior to his posting to Washington, Bond served as the British Ambassador to the Republic of Latvia from 2005 to 2007.
