Anna Grzymala-Busse is the Ronald and Eileen Weiser Professor of European and Eurasian Studies in the Department of Political Science at the University of Michigan, having previously taught at Yale University. She focuses on religion and politics, informal politics, and post-communist state development. Her first book, *Redeeming the Communist Past*, examined how discredited communist parties reinvented themselves as successful democrats. Her second book, *Rebuilding Leviathan: Party Competition and State Exploitation in Post-Communist Democracies* (2007) won the Association for Slavic, East European, and Eurasian Studies Ed A. Hewett Prize for best publication on the political economy of the former Soviet Union and East Central Europe.
