Hannes Adomeit is a Fellow of the joint German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and the American Institute for Contemporary German Studies (AICGS) Fellowship Program in Washington, D.C. He was until December 2007 Senior Research Associate at the Research Institute for International Politics and Security (SWP) in Berlin. Prior to that he was Professor for International Politics and Director of the Program on Russia and East-Central Europe at the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy at Tufts University in Boston and Fellow at the Harvard Russian Research Center. Dr. Adomeit holds university degrees from the Freie Universität Berlin (Diplom) and Columbia University, New York (Certificate in Russian Studies, M.A., and Ph.D. "with distinction"). He has worked with the EU's Conflict Prevention Network (CPN) on EU-Russia relations. Dr. Adomeit has published widely on Russia and Europe, including *Putin's Westpolitik*, with Rainer Lindner; *Die Gemeinsamen Räume Russlands und der EU*, with Anders Åslund: *Russia versus the United States and Europe or "Strategic Triangle"?* (all of which accessible on the SWP website www.swp-berlin.org).
