Response to the Terrorist Attacks in Paris Lecture by Hon. Philippe Létrilliart, Consul General of France

Following the horrific terrorist attacks in Paris on November 13th, 2015, the Consul General of France in Miami, Honorable Philippe Létrilliart, will comment and follow-up on what happened in France and what exceptional measures will be implemented to address the threat of terrorism.



Philippe Létrilliart assumed office of Consul General of France in Miami on September 3, 2013. He was previously Head of the Department in charge of Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean at the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2010-2013). Being assigned multiple times in Latin America, he began his professional stay abroad as a “coopérant” in Guatemala (1989-1990), before joining the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He subsequently held the position of First secretary at the Embassy of France in Havana (1996-2000). Recently, he served as the senior Advisor to the Embassy of France in La Paz (2006-2010). During his career, Mr. Létrilliart notably served at the Protocol (1993-1996) and handled multilateral affairs as Deputy Representative of France to the economic and social UN Commission for Asia and the Pacific in Bangkok (2000-2003). As part of the Center for Research and International Studies, he was also a Senior

lecturer at Sciences Po (2003-2006). He graduated from the Institut d’Etudes Politiques de Paris (Sciences-Po) and holds a Master of Contemporary History.
