Undergraduate Programs

Entrance requirements:



- a. High school diploma. Authorized by the government of Spain.
- b. Language Proficiency: DELE (Diplomas of Spanish as a Foreign Language) to demonstrate proficiency in Spanish.
- c. University Admission Test: Selectividad/EBAU = SAT



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Master's programs

Entrance requirements:



- a. Bachelor's degree. Authorized by the government of Spain
- b. Language Proficiency: Proficiency in Spanish or English
Depends on program
- c. Letters of recommendation / statements of purpose
Depends on school



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PhD programs

Entrance requirements:



- a. Master's degree. Authorized by the government of Spain
- b. Language Proficiency: Proficiency in Spanish or English depending on the program
- c. Research proposal

About the program

- 01** NALCAP is an educational outreach initiative of the Ministry of Education of Spain offering American college students and graduates the opportunity to be teaching assistants in Spain in classrooms across the country

Participants in the program assist lead teachers in the teaching of the English language and the culture of the US while immersed in the language and culture of Spain, promoting a cultural link between the citizens of these countries



What will you be doing?

- **Your tasks will include:**
 - Conducting conversation lessons
 - Giving cultural presentations
 - Attending department meetings
- And you may also be involved in **extra-curricular** activities



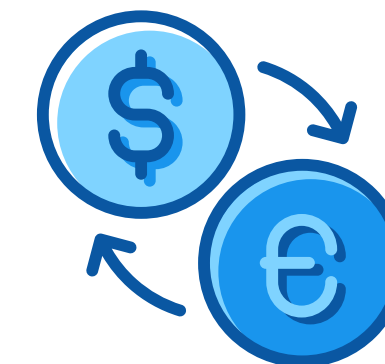
Program Requirements

- Be a **U.S. citizen** and **have a valid U.S. passport**
- Have a conferred **BA, BS, AA or AS degree** or be enrolled as a sophomore, junior or a senior in a BA or BS program
- Be a **native-like speaker of English**
- Be in **good physical and mental health**
- Have a clean **background check**
- Aged **18-60**



Program Conditions

- Schedule: Between **14 and 16 class periods** a week. Usually given a **3-day weekend**
- You will receive a monthly stipend of about **800 – 1,000€** depending on the region of Spain that you are assigned. You may supplement this grant with private classes
- Length of the program: **8 months** October 1 – May 31/ June 30 in Madrid
- **Medical insurance**
- An **orientation** course at the beginning of the school year
- An **official** certificate upon completion of the program

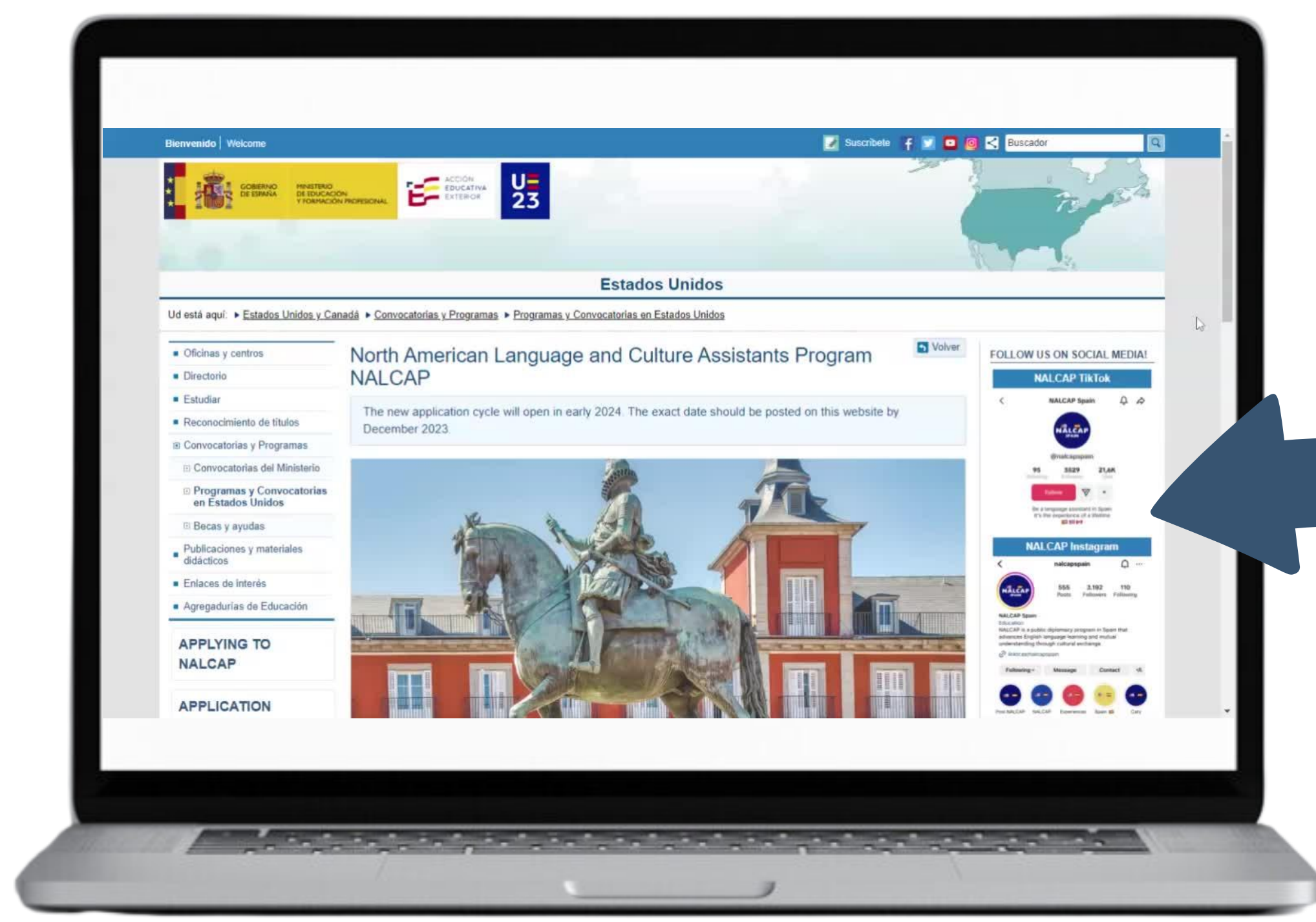


Apps open for 2024 Cycle late January/early February 2024

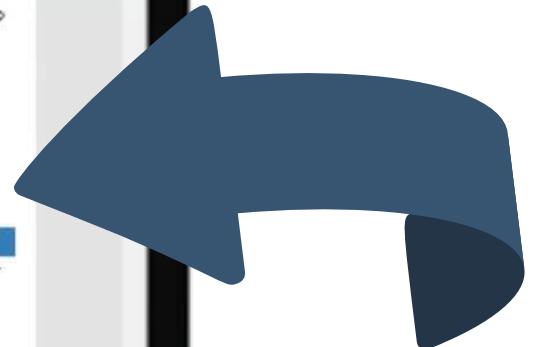

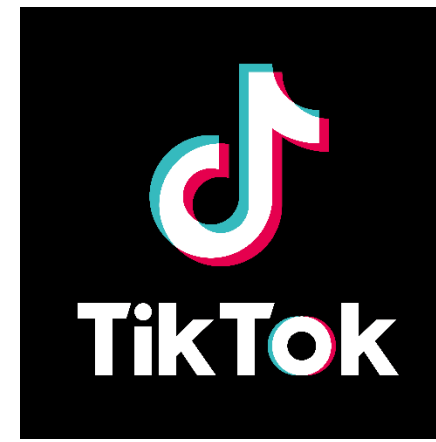
