**Pierre Delsaux** is Deputy Director General at the European Commission Directorate General for the Internal Market, Industry, Entrepreneurship and SMEs.

After studying Law at the University of Liège, he obtained his Master of Law at North-western University, Chicago, in 1983. He was Legal Secretary at the European Court of Justice from 1984 to 1987. He worked in the private sector before joining the European Commission in 1991. He started his career within the European Commission in the Directorate General for Competition.

He was appointed Director responsible for regulating the financial services in 2007. Following this, in 2011, he was appointed Deputy Director General with responsibilities for the Single Market in the EU.

Since December 2015, he has been in charge of the European Commission's space activities: **Space Policy** and **Research**, **Satellite Navigation (Galileo/EGNOS)** and **Earth observation (Copernicus)**, as well as **Defense Industries**.
