


Dual and Joint Degrees

Programs Taught in English

There are now over 1,600 degree programs in France that are taught in English.

As institutions in France evolve to attract and welcome international students from around the world, they are increasingly offering degrees programs taught in English to ensure these programs are accessible for non-Francophone candidates. These programs also prepare French students for global job markets.


French degree programs taught in English now include 125 undergraduate programs, 1,200 Masters programs, 90 short and professional courses, and 140 summer classes.

ETUDES EN FRANCE

DAP - Demande d'admission préalable

- Candidates to L1 and other firstyear undergraduate programs
- May apply to up to 3 programs

HDAP - Hors demande d'admission préalable

- Candidates to L2, L3, and Master's level programs
- May apply to up to 7 programs

DAP Candidates (including Architecture)

October 1, 2023: Opening of admission applications on the Etudes en France platform December 15, 2023 at 6 pm EST: Deadline for application submissions April 30, 2024: Deadline for French universities and institutions to accept or refuse candidates.

May 31, 2024: Deadline for candidates to accept one admission proposal

HDAP Candidates

October 1, 2023: Opening of admission applications on the Etudes en France platform January 1, 2024 at 6 pm EST: Deadline for application submissions

April 30, 2024: Deadline for French universities and institutions' responses and proposals for acceptance. Students will receive a response from the universities to which they have applied by this date.

May 31, 2024: Deadline for candidates to accept one admission proposal

French Ministry of Education program for young educators

 Every year, over 1,200 US young professionals are selected to teach in French public schools as part of the <u>Assistants de langue en France</u> program

7-month paid teaching assistant positions in public schools
