Program Requirements

- Be a U.S. citizen and have a valid U.S. passport
- Have a conferred **BA**, **BS**, **AA** or **AS** degree or be enrolled as a sophomore, junior or a senior in a BA or BS program
- Be a native-like speaker of English
- Be in good physical and mental health
- Have a clean **background check**
- Aged **18-60**

Program Conditions

- Schedule: Between **14 and 16 class periods** a week. Usually given a **3-day weekend**
- You will receive a monthly stipend of about 800 1,000€ depending on the region of Spain that you are assigned. You may supplement this grant with private classes
- Length of the program: 8 months October 1 May 31/ June
 30 in Madrid
- Medical insurance
- An **orientation** course at the beginning of the school year
- An **official** certificate upon completion of the program
