Pilar MÉNDEZ JIMÉNEZ, was born in Madrid in January the 11th 1973. In 1997 she obtained a Law Degree from the Universidad Pontificia de Comillas-ICADE in Madrid and in the year 2000 became diplomat for the Foreign Service of Spain.

As a diplomat Ms. Méndez Jiménez has served in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in different periods in positions where she has worked on the Organisation for Security and Co-operation in Europe –OSCE-, development and co-operation with Latin-America and Justice-Home Affairs of the European Union.

Abroad she has served as Deputy Head of Mission of the Embassy of Spain in Port-au-Prince, Haiti, Consul in the Consular Section of the Embassy of Spain in Tokyo and since September 2006 is Deputy Consul General of Spain in Miami. –Japan- and since September 2006 is Deputy Consul General of Spain in Miami -USA-.

She is fluent in German, French, English and Spanish.

In 2004 she was granted the “*Cruz de Oficial de la Orden de Isabel La Católica*” by H.M. King Juan Carlos I of Spain.
