**Cristina Barrios Almazor** is Consul General of Spain in Miami. She has been Ambassador at Large for the Reconstruction of Haiti, in Spain's Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation. Her extensive diplomatic career include appointment, in 1998, as Ambassador of Spain to Sweden and Latvia, and in 2002, as Ambassador of Spain to Mexico. She was later designated Ambassador at Large for Climate Change, attached to the Cabinet of the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation. Prior to her ambassadorial assignments she served in many positions, including director for Foreign Diplomatic and Consular Personnel, and for International Organizations Personnel, at the Protocol, Chancery and Orders Office. In 1982 she became Deputy Consul General of Spain in Dusseldorf. In 1986 she was made first Deputy Chief of Protocol at the Protocol, Chancer and Orders office, and in 1990 became Senior Chief of Protocol.
