L'Auberge Espagnole, 2002—French

A strait-laced French student moves into an apartment in Barcelona with a cast of six other characters from all over Europe. Together, they speak the international language of love and friendship.

The action takes place in Poland in 1938. This drama was based on the true story of a young German Jew who survived the Holocaust by falling in with the Nazis.

Good Bye Lenin, 2003—Germany

East Germany, the year 1989: A young man protests against the regime. His mother watches the police arresting him and suffers a heart attack and falls into a coma. Some months later, the GDR does not exist anymore and the mother awakes. Since she has to avoid every excitement, the son tries to set up the GDR again for her in their flat. But the world has changed a lot.
