Mr. Alberto Terenzi is an expert on climate adaptation and resilience and has an extensive track record of supporting the development of urban resilience and sustainability strategies in Europe. From 2011 to 2017, he worked for ICLEI, Local Governments for Sustainability, the leading global network of more than 1,500 cities, towns and regions committed to building a sustainable future. At ICLEI, he managed several European projects focused on supporting climate resilient decision-making, on creating peer-to-peer exchange and knowledge management platforms and on fostering knowledge brokerage between science and policy.

Throughout 2015, Alberto acted as a consultant to the City of Rome in the framework of the 100 Resilient Cities Project. Specifically, he was the city's strategic partner and advised them on the development of their preliminary resilience assessment. Alberto participated in the EU-funded projects RAMSES and RESIN, which both created scientific evidence and tools to support resilient and climate adaptive policy-making in cities. Currently, Alberto lives in Berlin, Germany, where he works as a freelance consultant.
