The Russian invasion of Ukraine has received widespread international condemnation. In this conversation with Ambassador Jakub Kulhánek, we will discuss the United Nations' response to the shock caused by this new reality, and its influence on the work of the Security Council, the General Assembly, the ECOSOC and other U.N. bodies and agencies, as well as regional groups. Considering that this violation of the foundational principles of the U.N. Charter has been carried out by a permanent member of the Security Council (with the right to veto), what can and should be expected regarding the organization's reform processes?
