- For Master's students, PhD candidates or postdocs with a well-defined research project
- Short term (1-6 months)
- Long term (7-12 months)
- Bi-national / Cotutelle degree program (12-18 months)
- Research Stays for University Academics and Scientists (1-3 months)
- Invitation by host institution essential
- Monthly support of € 934 for graduate students, €1,300 for PhD and postdocs; travel stipend; health & liability insurance

May 2, 2024 (short-term only)

Additional deadline: November 4th (short- & long-term)



RISE Professional

- For Masters & PhD students in Biology, Chemistry, Engineering, Geology, Computer Science and Physics (recent graduates eligible for some internships)
- Workplace internships 10 weeks to 6 months in leading German companies
- German requirements depend on the nature of the internship
- Scholarships and housing assistance are provided
- €934-1200 monthly stipend / minimum wage, international & domestic travel subsidy, health insurance
- Paid-for three-day RISE meeting in Heidelberg Germany

Representatives of supporter organizations can apply for event funding.





Application and Selection Process

- seek help from Fulbright Advisor at home institution
- Online application with Institute of International Education (IIE) opens in April – Deadline mid-October
- allow about 6 months to collect all required application documents and letters
- selection of semi-finalists through IIE regional screening committees – information in January
- selection of principal candidates through selection committees in Germany - information in April
