through transatlantic research*

The 2023 call for proposals is now open!



The Transatlantic Research Partnership fosters forward-looking collaborative research. It supports projects addressing **one or more United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**.

Applications should be **jointly submitted by two young researchers** (one in France and one in the United States).

Selected projects will receive a **20,000\$ grant** to be shared equally between the 2 partners over the course of **2 years**.

The **grant covers mobility between France and the US**, and costs of joint endeavors including the organization of conferences and publication fees.



Eligibility: Researchers at the **beginning of their career** (less than 15 years after obtaining their PhD) working in a French or American research or higher education institution.

French or US citizenship is not required.



Applications are accepted in all disciplines:

- Humanities and Social Sciences (HSS)
- Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM)
- Science for Society (interdisciplinary HSS-STEM projects)

As long as the **research project tackles one or several UN SDGs**.
