EU FACULTY CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT AWARD

Activities funded: We are particularly interested in broad-impact proposals including, but not limited to:

- Teaching workshops for faculty
- The production of pedagogical materials in support of efforts to internationalize curricula
- We fund faculty efforts to create new course on the European Union or infuse existing courses with at least 50 percent EU content.

OR

EU FACULTY RESEARCH GRANT

- All full-time faculty are eligible to apply .
- The award for FIU employees may be used for research expenditures clearly related to the EU, including travel, data and book acquisition, and the like.

Applications:

- Proposals should be no more than 800 words including a budget.
- Full-time FIU faculty are eligible to apply

- All funded activities need to be concluded by August 31st, 2026, and receipts must be submitted by September 7th, 2026.
